Team Read updates

- ◆ Each student will receive a postcard in early July signed by their tutor to remind them to keep reading throughout the summer months.
- ◆ All students received a spring book bag with books, activities, and flyers for area summer reading programs.
- ◆ All 3 High Schools will again participate and provide tutors for all 5 schools. Kamiakin and Southridge have a seventh hour class while Kennewick HS allows students to participate and receive volunteer hours.

Fast Facts:

- ☺ 148 tutors contributed 4,010.75 hours between October and mid-May. According to Independent Sector, the value of their volunteer time is \$83,624.14.
- ☺ 32 tutors volunteered over 40 hours each to the Team Read Program.
- ☺ Team Read tutored 240 students in the 2009-2010 school year.
- ☺ Seven fifth-grade Amistad KOG students tutored third graders this school year. This was a collaboration between Team Read, KOG teacher Mrs. Devine and third grade
